Capsule 1–1.5 cm, opening from the top down.




Leaves 2-7 cm, with a short petiole.





Petals 5, 7–10 mm, white; sepals 5, much shorter than petals; stamens 10; ovary 1, style consisting mostly of stigma. Blooms Apr 19–July 10.



Perennial evergreen subshrub, the flowering branches to 0.2 m. Dry woodlands, especially in sandy soil.
