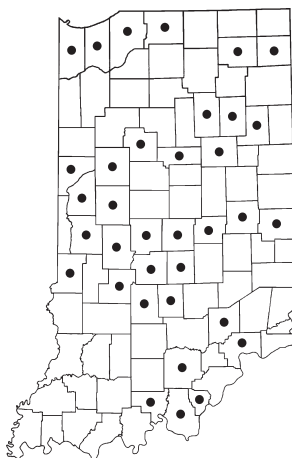


# *Dicentra canadensis*

Squirrelcorn

Fumariaceae [Gleason and Cronquist 1991], Papaveraceae [Judd et al. 2007]

Notes: *Dicentra canadensis* is native in Indiana; *D. cucullaria* is visually similar.

Petals 4, 2 outer and 2 smaller inner ones, the outer ones 12–16 mm long, white; sepals 2, usually fallen by flowering; stamens 6; ovary 1. Blooms Mar 31–May 30.

Bulblets globose, yellow, 0.4–0.6 cm long.

Perennial herb, the inflorescence a scape to 0.4 m. Woods.
