

Draba verna


Early Whitlow-Grass

Family: Brassicaceae [Gleason and Cronquist 1991, Judd et al. 2007]

Other name: *Erophila verna*

Notes: *Draba verna* is non-native in Indiana.

Petals 4, 2–4.5 mm, white, tip of petal deeply notched; sepals 1–2.5 mm; stamens 6; ovary 1, style 1. Blooms Mar 14–May 23.



Basal leaves in a rosette, the individual leaves 0.2–1.8 cm, margins and hairiness variable, no leaves on stem.



Fruit 0.4–0.9 × < 0.2 cm.



Annual herb to 0.2 m; inflorescence with leafless scape. Lawns, fields, roadsides.
