Tepals 6, 22–40 mm, white; stamens 6; ovary superior, style 1. Blooms Mar 29–May 13.



Leaf 8-22 cm, \pm flat, irregularly mottled on upper surface, unmottled on lower surface.



Scape 7–20 cm; plants sometimes cover large areas, but few flower. Woods.
