


# *Hydrophyllum appendiculatum*

## Appendaged Waterleaf

Family: Hydrophyllaceae [Gleason and Cronquist 1991],  
Boraginaceae [Judd et al. 2007]

Notes: *Hydrophyllum appendiculatum* is native in Indiana.

Corolla 9–13 mm long, 5-lobed to near the middle, lavender or pale pinkish purple; calyx 5-lobed to near the base; stamens 5, exerted 1–3 mm; pistil 1. Blooms Apr 27–July 11.


Stem leaf to 16 cm wide.

Inflorescence with thin hairs < 0.5 mm.

Biennial herb to 0.6 m; stem leaves palmately divided, about as long as wide, usually overtopped by the inflorescence. Woods.

Early leaves in a basal rosette, leaf 1½–2 times as long as wide, with hairs < 0.5 mm long.
