

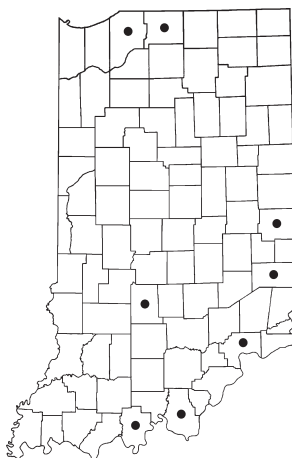
Microthlaspi perfoliatum

Perfoliate Pennycress

Family: Brassicaceae [Gleason and Cronquist 1991, Judd et al. 2007]

Other name: *Thlaspi perfoliatum*

Notes: *Microthlaspi perfoliatum* is non-native in Indiana; *Thlaspi arvense* is visually similar.



Petals 4, 1.5–3.5 mm long, white; sepals 4, 1–1.5 mm; stamens 6; ovary 1, style 1. Blooms Apr 5–May 11.

Basal leaves in a loose whorl; stem leaves 2–4 × 0.5–1.5 cm, clasping and cordate, the auricles rounded or broadly pointed.



Fruit 0.3–0.7 cm, about as wide as long, broadly winged all around, notch at tip of fruit is wider than deep.



Annual herb to 0.4 m. Roadsides, disturbed areas.
