## Phacelia purshii


Miami-Mist

Family: Hydrophyllaceae [Gleason and Cronquist 1991], Boraginaceae [Judd et al. 2007]

Notes: Phacelia purshii is native in Indiana.




Fruit a capsule to  $1 \times$ 0.8 cm.





Leaf to  $6 \times 2$  cm, the lower on leaf stalks to 2 cm long.





Corolla deeply 5-lobed, 5-13 mm wide, the lobes fringed, blue; calyx 5-lobed nearly to the base, shorter than the corolla lobes; stamens 5; ovary 1, style 1, 2-parted at tip. Blooms May 1-June 9.



Annual herb to 0.4 m, often forming large masses of plants. Wet roadsides, open woods.
