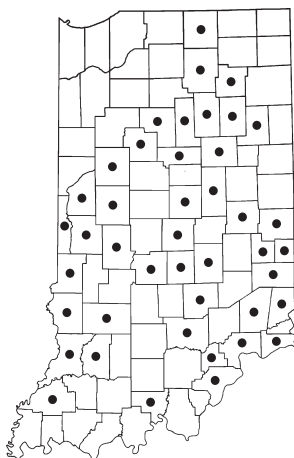


# *Phacelia purshii*

Miami-Mist

Family: Hydrophyllaceae [Gleason and Cronquist 1991],  
Boraginaceae [Judd et al. 2007]

Notes: *Phacelia purshii* is native in Indiana.

Corolla deeply 5-lobed, 5–13 mm wide, the lobes fringed, blue; calyx 5-lobed nearly to the base, shorter than the corolla lobes; stamens 5; ovary 1, style 1, 2-parted at tip. Blooms May 1–June 9.

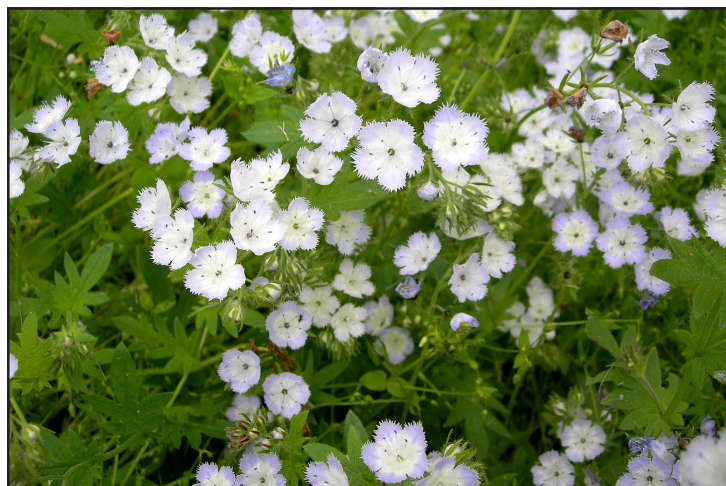
Fruit a capsule to 1 × 0.8 cm.

Leaf to 6 × 2 cm, the lower on leaf stalks to 2 cm long.

Annual herb to 0.4 m, often forming large masses of plants. Wet roadsides, open woods.
