


Scilla siberica

Siberian Squill

Family: Liliaceae [Gleason and Cronquist 1991], Hyacinthaceae [Judd et al. 2008]

Notes: *Scilla siberica* is non-native in Indiana; *Hyacinthoides non-scripta* is visually similar.



Capsule 0.4–0.6 cm.



Tepals 6, 12–16 mm, deep blue; stamens 6; ovary 1, style 1; bracts 1 or none per flower. Mar 20–May 4.

Leaves 2–4, 10–15 cm.



Bulb 1.5–2.5 cm.



Perennial herb to 0.2(–0.3) m; bulbs ovoid, 1.5–2 cm. Roadsides, lawns.
