Friday, Oct. 3: 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 4: 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Sunday, Oct. 5: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

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FEES AND TAXES

- Basic vendor spaces are 10'x10' and cost from \$500 per space as noted under registration.
- Double booth spaces start at a cost of \$1,500. Double booths are limited. Receipt date of full payment and contract are considered when assigning double booth spaces.
- Food truck spaces are \$250 per day of participation.
- A charge of \$75 is required for each electrical circuit (up to 4 max). See electrical requirements information in FAO.
- Tables are available to rent at \$50 for 2 tables (maximum of 2 tables per 10x10 space) on registration.
- \$50 per day for a temporary food permit, \$75 per event for propane permit, catering permit required for alcohol sales by the glass (see FAQ document for information, vendor to acquire appropriate permits).
- Missouri sales tax rules apply to vendor sales.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

Full payment is due by July 31, 2025. Vendors whose payments are not received by this date will forfeit their space. You may pay by credit or debit card through secure online payment processing through the electronic registration portal.

SET-UP & MARKET SCHEDULE

Thursday, October 2

10am – 6pm: Main lot tents, food court, craft beer & cocktail court vendor load-in/set-up

Friday, October 3

9am – 7pm: Market open

Saturday, October 4

5am – 7am: Booths must be restocked and all vehicles off the lot by 7am; NO EXCEPTIONS

8am – 9am: Market opens for Members-only shopping hour

9am: Market open to public

5pm: Market closes

Sunday, October 5

5am – 8am: Booths must be restocked and all vehicles off the lot by 8am; NO EXCEPTIONS

9am: Market open to public

5pm: Market closes. Early breakdown is prohibited! Vendors may not leave before 5 p.m.

5:30pm: Vendor vehicles allowed on the Garden parking lot

Food must be ready to serve by 10am on Saturday and Sunday (food truck/court vendors selling breakfast items may open at 8am Saturday and 9am Sunday).

Vendor booths must be staffed **AT ALL TIMES**, thus requiring that you provide a minimum of two staff at your booth.

Is ice available?

• Ice will be available at the Market for \$4 per bag. Ice chests will be filled each morning of the event. Once ice chest is empty for the day, it will not be filled again until the next day. We highly encourage vendors to bring their own ice.

Are chairs provided?
